

Your Body - Women

Ovary

You have two ovaries. They store tiny eggs and make hormones. An egg is released each month from one of the ovaries.

Cervix

This is also known as the neck of the uterus and is at the top of the vagina

Fallopian Tube

These tubes carry the egg from the ovaries to the uterus

Uterus

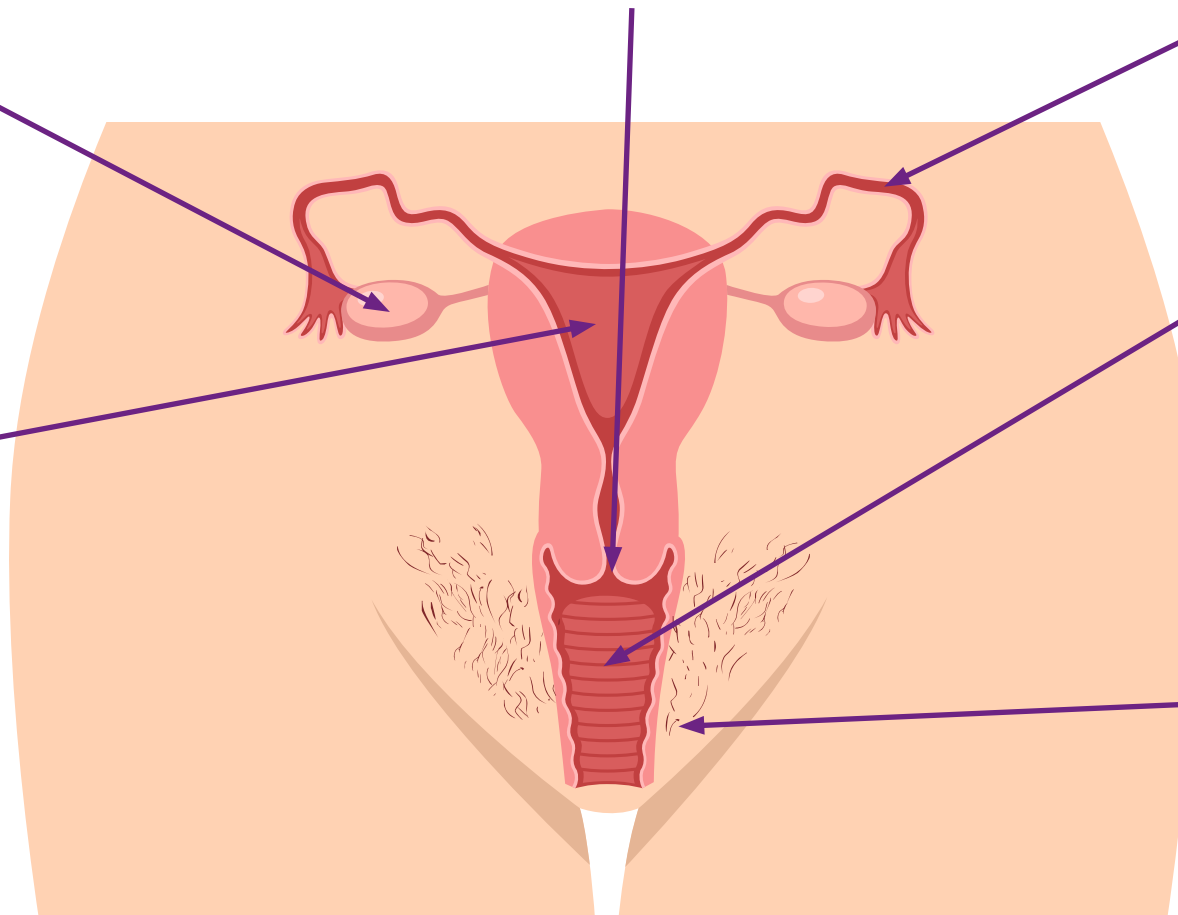
When a woman is pregnant the baby grows and develops in the uterus (womb). Every month the lining of the uterus gets thicker in case its needed to look after a growing baby. If the woman is not pregnant the lining breaks down and comes out as a period.

Vagina

Passageway between the uterus and the outside of the body. This is where menstrual fluid comes from during your period, where a penis enters during penetrative sex and the birth canal through which a baby is born, although the vagina is inside the body.

Vulva

The name given to all of the female's sex parts that are outside of the body. Lots of people use the term vagina, although the vagina is inside the body.



Urethra

The tube that carries urine from the bladder to outside your body.

Clitoris

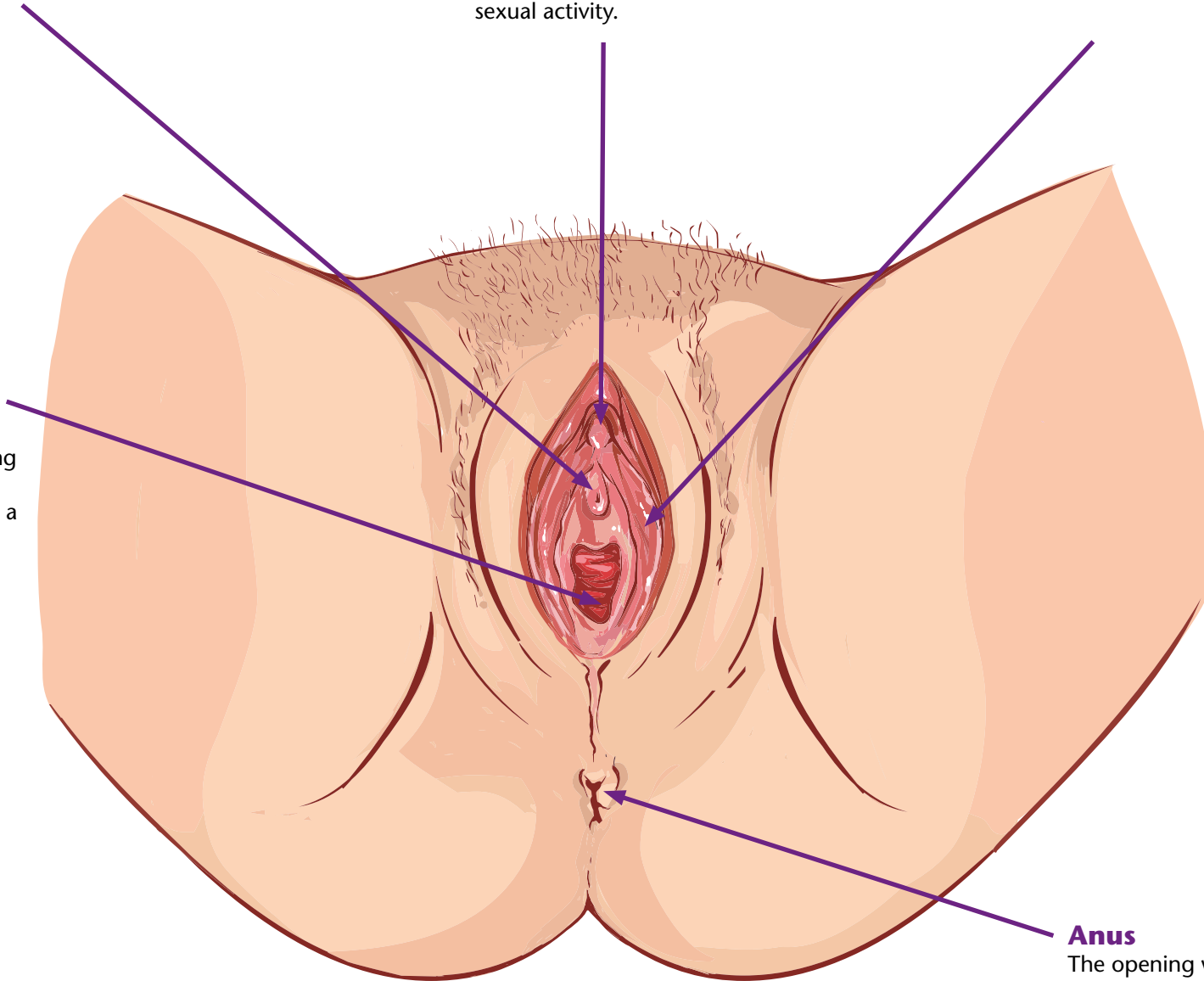
A small mound of skin which is very sensitive during masturbation or sexual activity.

Labia

Folds of skin, or lips, that cover the vagina opening.

Vagina

Anus

The opening where feces (poo) leaves your body.
