Urethral Swab	Gonorrhoea Group A Strep Group C or G Strep Unspecified streptococci	Managed by SHA Team Discuss with DOD No Action Required No Action Required
Cervical Swab	Gonorrhoea Group A Strep Group B Strep Trichomoniasis (TV)	Managed by SHA Team Discuss with DOD No treatment required Significant only in pregnancy therefore discuss with DOD as information requires to be shared with the woman's obstetric team Check client permissions & send Group B Strep information SMS Managed by SHA Team
HVS	Candida or anaerobes where clinic microscopy is positive and client treated Candida or BV where clinic microscopy Negative (or not performed) and client untreated Group B Strep	No further action - however confirmation results are available for future consultations Send client Thrush / BV SMS informing of result. No treatment required Significant only in pregnancy therefore discuss with DOD as information requires to be shared with the woman's obstetric team Check client permissions & send Group B Strep information SMS

Eye Swab	HSV GC CT Any other result e.g. Adenovirus	Discuss immediately with GU Consultant / DOD Discuss with DOD Managed by SHA Team Discuss with DOD
Neisseria Meningitidis	Positive result from urethral, rectal, cervical culture	Discuss with GU Consultant / DOD Clinician review
Biochemistry / Haematology	Abnormal result	Discuss with DOD or senior clinician if required





MSSU	Positive Culture	Check sensitivities vs treatment already given Advise client to see GP if recurrent / ongoing symptoms
Smear	ALO's Trichomonas vaginalis	Manage as per protocol Managed by SHA Team
