

SANDYFORD INCLUSION AND OUTREACH TEAM

The SIT/Outreach team provide sexual health related clinical care from Sandyford Central and Hunter Street Homeless Health Service as well as various Outreach locations. These services are available to anyone who requires extra support to be able to access clinical care within Sexual Health services in Greater Glasgow and Clyde. We aim to support patients to be able to easily make appointments.

Any adult (>18) with an on-going Sexual or Reproductive health need who falls in to any of the categories listed below can be referred to the Sandyford Inclusion/Outreach Team. For any urgent queries (e.g. HIV PEPSE, recent sexual assault) please follow usual referral pathways for this.

For patients who are able to make their own appointments, please direct them to www.sandyford.scot where they will be able to make a variety of appointment types online.

The remit of the team includes:

- To improve and facilitate access to Sandyford services for those who may otherwise struggle to do so
- To maximise the sexual health and wellbeing of vulnerable adults
- To ensure robust processes are in place to enable us to provide clinical care on an outreach basis
- To ensure referral pathways are clear and simple to use
- To promote the SIT with partner agencies and service users
- To identify areas of service need and continually develop approaches to address any gaps

The target groups include:

How to refer to the Inclusion/Outreach Team:

- Any adult with an ongoing Sexual or Reproductive health need and who falls in to any of the categories listed above can be referred to the Inclusion/Outreach Team.
- Any adult, following assessment with a clinician, who is perceived to need additional support can also be referred. These referrals will be vetted by the team and a decision made regarding their ongoing care needs.
- All referrals must be made using the NASH Internal Referral form. Q or email referrals will not be accepted.
- Urgent adult protection concerns should be discussed with the relevant Doc of the Day unless a member of the SIT/Outreach team is available for immediate advice.
